

# THE COMPANY OF THE BLACK SERPENT

HISTORICAL RE-ENACTMENT SOCIETY

## 1. NAME

1.1. The full name of the Society shall be The Company of the Black Serpent Historical Re-Enactment Society, generally shortened to “The Company of the Black Serpent”, “The Black Serpents”, or for the purposes of this document, “the Society”.

## 2. OBJECTIVES

2.1. The objectives of the Society are to organise and attend various re-enactment events, to provide a quality Living History encampment, and to allow its members to become skilled in the use of various historical weapons, combat techniques and crafts.

## 3. ORGANISATION

3.1. The Society will be run as a Constitutional Dictatorship by the leaders named below.

3.2. Officers may be seconded from the Society membership and granted titles, powers and duties as the Society leaders deem appropriate.

3.3. Officers can be released from their position at the discretion of the Society leaders.

## 4. MEMBERSHIP

4.1. Membership of the Society is by invitation by the Society leaders only.

4.2. Members will be required to complete a membership form and pay a non-refundable annual fee as determined by the Society leaders to cover the cost of insurance and paperwork.

4.3. Members will receive a copy of this Constitution, a copy of the Society Rules and Regulations, and any other documentation the leaders feel necessary, as part of their membership.

4.4. Members agree to abide by this Constitution and the Rules and Regulations.

4.5. The Society leaders reserve the right to refuse or revoke membership of the Society to any person as they see fit, and without right to appeal.

## 5. AMENDMENT

5.1. Amendments to this Constitution and the Rules & Regulations can only be made by the Society leaders, and cannot be back dated.

5.2. All Members will be notified of any change in this Constitution and Rules & Regulations.

## 6. LEADERS

6.1. The leaders of the Society are here named as Richard Ross and Michelle Ross.
